

Writing responsibilities and length of different sections:

1 page Executive Summary (coordinator)

Section 1 (carbon accounting: how much and when): Doug first draft by 10 May, circulate to Ande, Mark, Lorenzo (cc Bernhard). With their feedback, provide a draft to all by 17 May.

3 pages

Project types 2/3 page

1 page measurements, accounting and markets

pooling 1/3 page

Section 2 (Liability – who and at what times): Bernhard by May 24

Section 3 (criteria): Richard and Vincent will mail out current text to all on April 25. All to send comments to Richard and Vincent by 1 May, new draft from them by 9 May

Second part: apply criteria to “options” from sections 1 and 2. This will be done after a draft of sections 1 and 2 is available. This will involve those people who created the “options”. Richard and Vincent to do first “shot”, the others then to elaborate.

3 pages

Section 4: Model use to calculate carbon and \$ for the 4 examples (with some sensitivity analysis): **Staffan**, Louise, Bernhard, Claudio, Doug

Claudio to provide revised model by 9 May to the group. Everyone to “play” and test and provide feedback by 16 May. Some minor changes in the following week. Then scenario calculations begin. Staffan, with Doug and Lorenzo, to provide the carbon curves as input to the model (4 scenarios, with possibly some sub-scenarios) by 9 May to Claudio. Time period = 120 years. Graphs should differ among scenarios over the first 20-30 years.

Intended use of the paper:

- Possibly UNFCCC submission in July (this will be known only after SBSTA in first 2 weeks of June)
- Website / climate mailing list in July
- Climate Policy, Environmental Science and Policy, or TheScientificWorld (faster and online)
- Should all 3 papers be published as a group?

The full paper (for journal publication) will be submitted around September. Andre agrees to have some time available for “polishing” in August. For the submission in July: if we run into time problems, the first thing to skip is the cost analysis (but will be included in journal paper).
